9: Selection Process

(A) Initial Screening

Submitted documents will go through an initial screening process. Applicants will be judged based on their demonstrated research ability, and also if their research interests are compatible with the goals of the lab. Successful applicants will be invited to an interview, either online or at the Kyoto Laboratory.

(B) Kyoto Lab Interview

The applicant will be asked to give a talk in front of all members at the Kyoto Laboratory, outlining past achievements and future research plans. Applicants who pass this stage will be invited for a job talk, either online or at the Kyoto Laboratory.

(C) Job Talk

The applicant will be asked to give a talk in front of all members at Sony CSL (both Tokyo and Kyoto) including the company president, outlining past achievements and future research plans. The job talk must be given in English, standard duration is one hour including Q&A.

(D) Final Decision

The company will make its final decision regarding the applicant. Successful applicants will receive a job offer from the company president.

10: Compensation

- Compensation will be determined based on the applicant's qualifications, experience, and demonstrated ability.
- Applicants residing overseas who must relocate to Japan to work at Sony CSL (provided that neither they nor their family members own housing within commuting distance from the Kyoto Laboratory) are eligible to receive relocation assistance and rent subsidies.
